What's in this release

This release lands the first version of Review Center, adds several App Support capabilities so support admins can resolve access and payment questions without engineering, and turns on per-user impersonation. Bulk document upload is now self-service for mapping appointment types to document categories. Feature flags have been re-platformed for reliable per-user targeting. Behind the scenes, several endpoints moved off MongoDB onto Connect GQL, and we tightened up authorization letters, authorization creation, and a stack of bug fixes across the portal.

New capabilities

Review Center

The first version of Review Center is live. Set up reviews, work through the member queue, and record HCC and Quality items per member. Includes a Review Setup screen, Member Queue, and Member Review Detail. **Gated behind a feature flag and hidden for all users except the pilot group.** (AM-5474)

App Support (admin tool)

Manage User Manager accounts

App Support Admins can view User Manager accounts and the users they've invited, and re-assign or remove those users, so access issues can be handled without looping in engineering. (AM-5428)

Bulk portal invites

Send portal invites to many users at once from the admin tool by pasting a list or uploading a file, with row-level validation up front. (AM-5436)

Search EOBs and checks by IPA and check/EOB number

Admin search now returns EOBs and checks by IPA and check or EOB number, matching the capability the team was using in DM Reports. (AM-5437)

Search rejected batch claims with submitter email

Search rejected batch claims and see the submitting user's email on each result, so support can notify impacted users directly instead of going back to engineering and the EDI team. (AM-5438)

Impersonation ("View as")

Impersonation is now gated behind a per-user "Impersonation" attribute (modeled on the existing "Reports" attribute) so it can be granted to specific users instead of being on for a whole role. This is what unlocks turning "View as" on safely in production. (AM-5521)

Bulk Document Upload

Self-service appointment-type to document-category mapping

Super Admins can now manage the mapping from Excel "Appt Type" values to document categories directly in the admin UI, instead of asking engineering to add a new mapping every time an appt type isn't covered. (AM-5489)

New mappings for COMM, PROS, and SNF appointment types

Added mappings for commercial annual physicals, prospective APes, and SNF appointment types coming out of the Elation worklist, with a default to HEDIS when no specific mapping matches. (AM-5552)

Authorizations

Deep-links from astrana-ui-modules into Provider Portal auth flow

Auth creation and auth actions (duplicate, modify) can now be launched from astrana-ui-modules with deep-links that bypass the re-auth modal in Provider Portal. (AM-5412)

Auth failure detection and recovery

When a Provider Portal auth fails, the system now detects it, recovers the missing data if it happened in the last hour, and otherwise re-creates the auth and cancels the original with a clear cancellation note and alert. (AM-5411)

Auth letters include Referral Type and Referring Provider

Authorization letters now include Referral Type (Routine, Urgent, STAT) and Referring Provider details again. Diagnostic Medical Group's AI fax processing relies on these fields, and recent letter formats had dropped them. (AM-5588)

Feature Flags

Unique-name model with email-additive targeting

Feature Flags moved to a new model with a unique-name table and email-additive targeting, plus an updated admin UX. This fixes the duplicate-name rows and the "AND across dimensions" behavior that were breaking the old "OR across rows" semantics. (AM-5622)

Access control

Quality & Risk tab fully restricted

The Quality & Risk tab off the Overview page is now completely locked down. No role, IPA, feature flag, or user can reach it. (AM-5624)

Under the hood

NMM portal API migration to Provider Portal API — Phase 1.1

First phase of migrating NMM portal auth endpoints onto the Provider Portal API. (AM-5165)

MongoDB to Connect GQL

Several endpoints moved off MongoDB and onto Connect GQL as part of the broader Mongo deprecation: general Mongo endpoints, PAF endpoints, and the Daily Prep List data source. Frontend was updated to use the new endpoints. (AM-5419, AM-5472, AM-5536, AM-5554)

UI enhancements

What changed	What you'll notice
Reset button on EOB search	The EOBs search filters now have a Reset button that clears all fields, dropdowns, and date pickers in one click. (AM-5570)

Bug fixes

Issue	What we fixed
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Review Center — RAF score didn't match between Review Center and the HCC Risk Score screen.	RAF scores are now consistent across both screens. (AM-5564)
Review Center — member name format was inconsistent on the Review Detail screen.	Member names now use the same format as the rest of the portal (Member Search, M360, Claims, Auths). (AM-5565)
Review Center — canceling a new review didn't clear the entered data or reset the workflow.	Cancel now discards entered data and returns the flow to a clean state. (AM-5566)
Review Center — Member Queue search returned no results when searching by Member ID.	Member Queue search now returns matches when searching by Member ID. (AM-5567)
Review Center — an incomplete HCC or Quality item added to one Pending Approval member also showed up on other members.	HCC and Quality items are now scoped correctly to the member they were added on. (AM-5569)
Review Center — editing an existing review created a new review instead of updating the original.	Editing now updates the existing review in place. (AM-5617)
Impersonation — an impersonated user couldn't navigate away from the Quality & Risk AVC Chase List page.	Navigation works normally while impersonating, including away from the AVC Chase List. (AM-5501)
Impersonation — the impersonation popup at the bottom of the screen blocked the pagination controls.	The popup no longer overlaps pagination. (AM-5517)
Create Authorization — clicking Step 4, 5, or 7 in the step tracker scrolled the page up and hid Step 1.	Clicking step-tracker entries no longer causes unexpected scrolling. (AM-5561)
Create Authorization — phCode "O" was being sent as "P" in the submit payload for document-autofilled proc codes, causing auths to fail against the rmifinished table.	phCode values are preserved end-to-end on document-autofilled proc codes. (AM-5538)
Create Claim — placeholder text overlapped selected values in form fields.	Placeholder text no longer overlaps selected values. (AM-5541)
Authorization Letter — GetAuthLetterInfo API failed when clicking View Docs.	View Docs now loads authorization letter documents. (AM-5612)
Authorization Letter — search returned no results when a Status filter was applied, even when matching letters existed.	Status-filtered searches now return the correct results. (AM-5614)
Authorization Letter — search failed with a 400 error when using the DOB filter.	DOB filter searches now succeed. (AM-5615)

Overview — Overview tab showed "No Data" after re-login until the page was refreshed.	Overview loads data on re-login without needing a manual refresh. (AM-5547)
Overview — the Authorization card displayed "Undefined" and "Unknown Patient."	The Authorization card now shows the correct authorization and patient information. (AM-5613)
Member360 — the Diagnosis status dropdown only showed one option after adding a diagnosis.	The full list of diagnosis status options now displays after adding a diagnosis. (AM-5520)
Bulk Upload — "Test an Appointment Type" expanded outside the Manage Mappings modal with no scrollbar.	The Manage Mappings modal now contains the test section and scrolls when it grows. (AM-5572)
Bulk Upload — the "insurance" classification mapping was ignored; documents landed in General Attachment instead of Insurance / Eligibility Docs.	The insurance pattern now maps correctly to Insurance / Eligibility Docs. (AM-5576)
Feature Flags — Administrator role could access the page, but /GetUserAccounts returned 401 Unauthorized.	Administrator role now works end-to-end on the Feature Flags page. (AM-5548)
Feature Flags — CreateAuthV2 flag showed as Disabled under "Resolve for User" even when it was enabled for that user, and "Why?" was blank.	"Resolve for User" now reflects the correct state and populates "Why?" with the resolution reason. (AM-5550)
Feature Flags — after creating a new flag, existing flags could no longer be updated.	Existing flags update correctly after creating a new one. (AM-5558)
Feature Flags — DailyVisitPrep was enabled for all users instead of only the specific user emails configured.	User-email targeting now restricts the flag to the selected users only. (AM-5621)
User screen — an invalid role option "8" appeared in the Role dropdown.	The Role dropdown now only shows valid role options. (AM-5535)
Request for a New Member — the DOB calendar was cut off at the top and the Submit button was crowded against the page edge.	The calendar renders in full and the Submit button has proper spacing. (AM-5519)
Batch Claim Submitted — the screen took excessive time to load after uploading a batch claim.	Submitted Batch Claims now loads within an acceptable response time. (AM-5539)
EOBs — the Medical Group dropdown took excessive time to load and locked up the UI.	Medical Group dropdown loads quickly and no longer blocks the UI. (AM-5571)

Daily Visit — the Daily Visit tab didn't display for the test account even with all Daily Visit Prep feature flags enabled.

The Daily Visit tab now displays when the required flags are enabled. (AM-5577)

Patient Resources — the Document, Category, and Actions column headers were missing on the Patient Resources tab.

Column headers now display on the Patient Resources tab. (AM-5606)
