What's in this release

Highlights this release: a simplified patient approval letter you can print straight from the Auth Details panel, a revamped Administrator People page, a self-serve training catalogue with due dates and first-login prompts, a Tour Builder phase adding guided practice and publish validation, a new Quality Gap review questionnaire, and stability improvements across Member 360. Plus a large batch of authorization, Administrator, Create Claim, and Member 360 fixes coming out of the ongoing AstraConnect and Provider Portal parity work.

Prior Auth

Vendor name shown and searchable on the Create Auth provider list

The provider's vendor name now displays alongside the provider name in the specialty/provider selection list on Create Authorization and is searchable, so the right provider/vendor pair is easier to locate. (AM-5859)

Simplified patient approval letter

A new one-page, plain-language patient letter can be printed from the Auth Details side panel, alongside the existing Print Auth Details option. It tells the patient who to see, where, by when, and what to bring — without the clinical notes, ICD codes, or CPT lines carried on the provider-facing sheet. Access is scoped to the caller's IPA. (AM-5007)

Auth Details print now scoped to the caller's IPA

The Auth Details print endpoint now verifies the caller's IPA before returning member PHI. (AM-5862)

Single permanent IPA Advise alert band on Create Auth

The "Need help choosing a provider?" (IPA Advise) option now shows as a single permanent alert band on Create Auth, so providers who want UM to help pick a provider don't miss it. (AM-5499)

Auth history ordering

Auth History now orders authorizations by date descending, matching the primary view when the fallback endpoint is used. (AM-5852)

Invalid CPT / ICD-10 / HCPCS code alerts

Invalid CPT, ICD-10, or HCPCS codes are now flagged in red when selected. If a provider continues with an invalid code, the auth is blocked at approve/submit. (AM-5834)

Stability and performance

Deadlock retry and a data-type fix on auth master updates, a fix to a crash in auth note filtering, and a fix to the sequence error that could occur on attachment save. Auth workflows are more resilient under load. (AM-6275, AM-6271)

Admin

People page revamp

The Administrator People page now uses a full-width table with a unified user record, inline invite, and assigned TINs visible on each record. Existing TINs populate correctly on Edit Member. Ships on top of the Phase 2 per-page Administrator redesign. (AM-5666, AM-5876)

Health Plan Code — bulk select, search, and keyboard navigation

The Health Plan Code field on Edit User now supports bulk select, discoverable search, and keyboard navigation. With ~225 codes available, configuring an account is no longer a one-checkbox-at-a-time job. Now visible to all admins. (AM-5942)

Bulletins can be deleted or deactivated

Bulletin banners can now be deleted or deactivated from the admin surface, so outdated messages don't have to hang around. (AM-5674)

API Performance monitoring page (SE Admin only)

A new admin page for tracking API performance and failure trends, available to SE Admin only.

Cleaner "Never signed in" display

Removed the misleading placeholder Last Login value for users who had never signed in. Exports show "Never Signed In" instead of a blank cell, and the status refreshes as expected after first sign-in. (AM-5885)

Administrator redesign shell (Phase 1)

Pressing Administrator in the side nav opens a single Administrator tab alongside the rest of your work, landing on a service-tile page. Ships as the reusable shell the per-page redesigns build on. (AM-5654)

Bulk Invite usability and error reporting

Bulk Invite now includes Select All / Deselect All on the IPA list, hides inactive records, and returns clearer errors when a batch fails. (AM-5815)

Training & Tours (gated behind feature flag)

In development. All items in this section are hidden behind a feature flag and are not visible to users until they're ready for broader rollout.

Self-serve optional training catalogue

Portal users can browse and self-enroll in optional courses in addition to any required training assigned to them. (AM-5867)

Training due dates, deep links, and first-login prompt

Assigned courses can now carry due dates, be linked to directly, and prompt the user on first login. The first-login prompt is persisted server-side so it doesn't fire on every browser. (AM-5860)

Course assignment and completion tracking (Super Admin)

Super Admins can assign training courses to specific users, roles, or organizations, mark courses as required, set due dates, and see who has completed them. (AM-5450)

My Training for end users

Portal users get a My Training page listing assigned courses with status, required badge, due date, and per-course progress. (AM-5451)

Tour Builder — Phase 4

Adds guided practice gates, step setup actions and wait conditions, sample-file attachments, publish validation, and a built-in dogfood tour of the Tour Builder itself. (AM-5888)

Admin Tours behind a feature flag

The admin Tours tab is now gated behind a TourManagement feature flag so it can be shown or hidden per environment, IPA, role, or email. (AM-5847)

Member 360

Panel stability

The Member 360 panel now stays open when switching members, resolves the correct companyId, and no longer shows stale search results between navigations. M360 component bumped to 0.5.18. (AM-5945, AM-5949, AM-6261, AM-6262)

Restrict Create Authorization by member type and role

The Create Authorization button on Member 360 is now hidden for restricted member types and roles. (AM-5745)

Review Center

Available to internal Quality & Risk users only, and limited to users who have been specifically enabled. Items in this section apply only to those users.

Quality gap review questionnaire on the member workbench

A quality gap review questionnaire is now available directly from the member workbench, so reviewers can capture responses inline instead of jumping between screens.

Server-side worklist hydration from cohort filters

Review worklists now hydrate from cohort filters on the server, so lists load consistently and faster.

Patient Priority worklist

The Patient Priority worklist has been brought into 130.1. (AM-5603)

Quality Gaps and HEDIS reports

Incomplete members sort to the top of Quality Gap

The Quality Gap outreach list defaults to sorting Incomplete members first. About 9% of the current campaign is Incomplete, and those are the records that still need action. (AM-6273)

Cleaner glycemic quality gap display

The Member 360 Quality Gaps card no longer shows the "Glycemic Status >9.0%" measure alongside the standard glycemic measure — they were reading as two competing A1c targets. (AM-6274)

Full HEDIS measure names in the Gap Report

The HEDIS Gap Report now shows full measure names instead of abbreviations, so providers who aren't familiar with the shorthand can read the report without translating. (AM-6277)

ACO Line of Business restored in Quality & Risk

The ACO Line of Business option is available again in the Quality & Risk tab. (AM-5748)

Commercial members now appear on the AV Chase List

The AV Chase List previously pulled only AWW (Medicare) members. Its filter has been updated to include the APE, WCV, W30A, and W30B submeasures, so Commercial Health Plan members now surface on the list. Switching Health Plans updates the member list, and Chase List functions (Digital PAF, Print PAF, status changes) continue to work as expected. (AM-5920)

Claims

SaveClaim fixes

SaveClaim now uses the correct column names in diagnosis and CPT validation, returns a normalized response model, and normalizes error bodies. Migrated endpoints have been repointed off the legacy nmmPortal traffic that was still coming in from the frontend. (AM-5937, AM-5864)

Provider Demographic Attestation form (California only)

Rolled out to California providers only. Items in this section apply only to providers in California.

"No Longer with Organization" option

Offices can now flag a provider who no longer practices there, so terminated providers can be closed out cleanly instead of being attested for. (AM-5480)

Form updates (7/29): inline per-section update requests

The bottom-of-form change-request cascade has been replaced with per-section inline "updates are needed" checkboxes. The W-9 upload is now inline under the Tax ID checkbox. DEA and CAQH fields are conditionally locked, and the Gender + Confirmation block has been removed. (AM-5818)

Other

AWV — vendorId threaded through provider selection

The AWV flow now threads vendorId through provider selection so backend vendor/TIN filtering can apply correctly.

Eligibility — priority providers pinned and searchable

On the Contact Information > Provider dropdown when adding a new patient, priority providers (like AP Urgent Care) are now pinned to the top, and the dropdown supports search. (AM-5849)

AP Urgent Care location dropdown restored

Users assigned to AP Urgent Care now see all three of their assigned locations (Monterey Park, Arcadia, City of Industry) in the location dropdown again. (AM-5850)

Feature-gated routes no longer flash before the flag resolves

Routes controlled by a feature flag no longer briefly render before the flag resolves, so users don't see a page appear and then disappear. (AM-5847)

Nightly refresh of facility data across IPA databases

A nightly job now refreshes RmiFacilities across all IPA databases, so newly added facilities show up in Create Authorization without a manual refresh. (AM-5370)

MOC Attestation report for AHISP CLEVER CARE HP

Ad-hoc report pulled for 2025–2026 MOC Attestation data with the audit-level detail set. Follow-up work in progress to bring these fields into the general training attestation report. (AM-5910)

Bug fixes — Prior Auth

Issue	What we fixed
Modify Authorization was available for all auths and didn't enforce the same validation as Provider Portal.	Modify Authorization now enforces the same validation rules. (AM-5830)
View By Status — the Authorization Detail page redirected to the Member Authorization List after selecting a row.	The Detail page now stays open on the selected auth. (AM-5843)
The Create Auth button navigated to the Overview page instead of Create Auth.	Create Auth now opens the Create Auth screen. (AM-5848)
Authorization Submission Rules — the IPA list wasn't displayed in the Select IPA dropdown.	The IPA list now populates in Select IPA. (AM-5887)

Auth Submission Rules API failed on the Auth Submission Rules tab.	The Auth Submission Rules tab loads without errors. (AM-6301)
IPA switch between APC and its sub-IPAs wasn't working, causing auth creation failures.	IPA switching now works between APC and sub-IPAs. (AM-6282)

Bug fixes — Create Claim

Issue	What we fixed
The Provider Selection popup UI was distorted when creating a claim.	Provider Selection now renders correctly. (AM-5824)
Selecting "No" on questionnaire questions didn't show an active selection state.	"No" now shows a clear active state when selected. (AM-5825)
Diagnosis description wasn't displayed after selecting a diagnosis code.	Diagnosis description now displays alongside the code. (AM-5826)
CPT codes and Place of Service descriptions were missing.	Full descriptions now display for both. (AM-5827)
The Create Claim page crashed when opening the file upload dialog.	The file upload dialog opens cleanly from Attachments. (AM-5828)
All Create Claim steps were marked complete but submission failed with no visible errors.	Submission validation now surfaces the actual blocking errors. (AM-5831)
Claim Reference Number wasn't displayed on the Claim Submission screen after creation.	Claim Reference Number now displays on Claim Submission. (AM-6271)
Claims were being rejected due to a missing ZIP code in the member address.	Member address ZIP is now included so claims aren't rejected on that check. (AM-6313)

Bug fixes — Administrator

Issue	What we fixed
Administrator — the header showed "Overview" instead of "Administrator."	The Administrator header now labels correctly. (AM-5853)
Administrator — Member status showed Enabled in search results but Disabled in the details view.	Search results and details now show the same status. (AM-5877)
Administrator — an invalid IPA Group Admin displayed under IPA Groups on Member Details.	IPA Group Admin now shows the correct value. (AM-5878)

Administrator — the Account Access toggle displayed the wrong status and showed duplicate success messages.	Toggle status is accurate and success messages no longer duplicate. (AM-5879)
The close (X) icon on the input box on the invitation screen was slightly misaligned.	The close icon now aligns correctly. (AM-5880)
Administrator — the Rows per Page option was missing from Invitations tab pagination.	Rows per Page is available on Invitations pagination. (AM-5881)
Administrator — the Last Login column was blank for exported Member records for users who had never signed in.	Exports now show "Never Signed In" instead of a blank value. (AM-5882)
Administrator — Member status filter counts changed incorrectly when switching between filters.	Status filter counts now update correctly across filter changes. (AM-5883)
Administrator — Invitation status filter counts didn't update after performing a search.	Invitation filter counts now refresh with the search. (AM-5884)
SubmitUserEdit failed when saving provider changes on Edit User.	Provider changes now save on Edit User. (AM-5934)
Vendor Portal Users API returned a 400 error when accessed from the Administrator tab.	Vendor Portal Users loads from the Administrator tab. (AM-6266)
Vendor Portal — creating a vendor portal user failed with a 500 error due to a foreign key constraint.	Vendor Portal user creation now succeeds. (AM-5886)
Registration Section APIs were failing in the Admin tab.	Registration Section now loads in the Admin tab. (AM-6291)
People — adding a Provider failed after selecting "Add Selected" during a User Edit.	"Add Selected" now completes adding a provider. (AM-6295)
Administrator navigation tray labelled pills overflowed the header at narrow widths.	The nav tray now reacts to viewport width without overflow. (AM-6296)

Bug fixes — Member 360

Issue	What we fixed
Eligibility endpoint failed with a service error and eligibility didn't load.	Eligibility now loads reliably in Member360. (AM-5841)
The Medications tab took an excessive time to load.	Medications now loads within an acceptable response time. (AM-5856)

Auths filter — the Request Date datepicker didn't apply to search results.	The Request Date filter now applies to search results. (AM-5863)
Member 360 displayed "Patient Not Found" when opened from Quality Gaps.	Member360 opens correctly from Quality Gaps. (AM-5875)
Member 360 header showed "Patient not found" for ACO members opened from Chase List.	ACO members from Chase List now load correctly. (AM-6262)
AV Chase List — Member 360 data didn't load for members under a specific provider.	Member 360 loads correctly regardless of the referring provider on Chase List. (AM-6268)
Member 360 failed to load for some Chase List members due to empty search responses.	Member search now returns results for these members and Member 360 opens. (AM-6312)

Bug fixes — Other

Issue	What we fixed
Notification unread count API continuously returned 404 while on any page.	The unread count no longer generates repeat 404 errors. (AM-5845)
Eligibility — Member Report displayed the wrong eligibility status and exported reports/PDFs disagreed with Member 360.	Member Report, Member 360, and exported reports now all show the same status. (AM-5838)
Tour Builder — the UI became corrupted when adding a new step while editing a saved tour.	Adding steps to a saved tour no longer corrupts the builder. (AM-5869)
Tour Builder — the Tour Template Preview redirected to the Overview page instead of previewing the template.	Template Preview now shows the selected template. (AM-6276)
Training — assigned training didn't start when users clicked Start.	Start now launches the assigned training. (AM-6292)
Quality & Risk — Health Plan mismatched between AV Chase List and PAF Submission pages.	Health Plan is consistent across AV Chase List and PAF Submission. (AM-6263)
